COST

- Per Family Registration Fee = \$150/yr
- Monthly Per Class Cost = \$60-100
- Annual Per Class Supply Fees = \$50-60 on average

WHO WE ARE

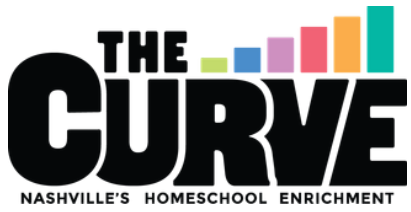
